1. Name of the Award

Dr. S.P. Singh Memorial Award for "Lifetime Achievement in Biological Control"

2. Sponsor

Society for Biocontrol Advancement, Bengaluru.

3. Objectives of the Award

- (i) To recognize outstanding research in the field of biological control of crop pests and weeds.
- (ii) Pioneering contribution to the progress, impact and popularity of biological control.

4. Nature of the Award

This award is primarily meant for agricultural scientists for life time contribution in biological control of crop pests and weeds.

5. Frequency

Annual

6. Eligibility Criteria

All Indian scientists engaged in biological control of crop pests and weeds. The research work must be original and must have been conducted under well-focused, research programme/project in India. The award is meant for individual scientist for their extraordinary, original, creative life time contributions in advancement of basic sciences, concepts, development of new technology and sustainability of agriculture, not restricted to NARS.

7. Administration of the Award

There shall be a Panel of Judges, including the Chairperson and at least one member from outside the NARS, to evaluate the applications and make recommendations to the President, SBA. The panel will be appointed by the President, SBA and Secretary, SBA, Bengaluru.

8. Evaluation Criteria

- Conceptual clarity and originality of the research work
- Scientific, technological and socio-economic relevance
- Significant Advancement in biological control Science/Technology generated/

developed/ Patents obtained, etc.

- Quality of research publication, Numbers of Research papers published in journals with current (2016) NAAS Rating of ≥ 6
- Citation as seen in Google Scholar for 20 best research papers
- Potential of research findings for increasing agricultural production, productivity, profitability and sustainability in the relevant agricultural system

9. Procedure

Nominations/Application for the award will be invited by the Society for Biocontrol Advancement, Bengaluru by hosting on website. Nominations/Application are to be made in the prescribed form obtainable from the Secretary, SBA or can be downloaded from website. The Panel of Judges will screen the nominations, identify outstanding entries, and make recommendations to the President, SBA, Bengaluru, along with the draft citations.

10. Presentation

The presentation of award will be made during the General Body Meeting of SBA during the year. The award carries a memento and citation.

11. Documentary Proof

All necessary proof including reprints of top 20 research papers should be attached with proforma.
